

# 2022 FEEDER CALF PROGRAM

## NEW DETAILS & CHANGED INFORMATION

As a cattle marketer, our goal is to continually improve the Norwood Feeder Calf Program every year to support our local producers in marketing your feeder cattle at a top price and providing high quality calves to buyers. In an effort to do this, we have implemented a few changes for the 2022 feeder calf sales that are highlighted below. We hope that you will continue to market your cattle with us through the Graded Feeder Calf Program as we strive to meet the industry demand for high-quality and healthy cattle.

### NEW Changes:

- Cattle consigned to the June, August, September, and November Weaned Sales are required to be **weaned 60 DAYS** prior to sale day.  
(The March weaned sale will remain at 45 days for 2022 only).
- While the requirements for the types of vaccines remain the same, please note that cattle must be vaccinated with **two rounds of each required vaccine between 21-90 days** before the sale. There must be at least 21 days between each round of vaccine administered and the pasteurella must be given within 70 days of the sale. If you vaccinate calves while they are young, you may still be required to do two additional rounds of vaccination to fall in the 90 day vaccination window.
- There will be **NO Non-Weaned Regular Sales** this year.  
\*\*Please see the pages included for the NEW MAC-Vac (calf vaccination) program beginning in April 2022. Non-weaned cattle can be marketed through this new program at Stanly County Livestock Market & Harward Brothers Livestock Markets selling individually or in single producer groups.

### Important Notes to Remember:

- Cattle **must be consigned** for every sale.
  - If you decide not to bring consigned cattle to a sale, please let a representative know as soon as possible. As we usually have waiting lists for the sales, that will allow someone to sell in those spots.
- Cattle must have a sale ear tag in the calf's right ear prior to arrival at the stockyard.
  - We request that all other tags, including fly tags and farm ear tags, be removed before sale day.
- After the tag request has been made, tag delivery may take **at least 1 week** before getting to the farm. Please make tag requests ASAP to help representatives coordinate delivery in a timely manner.
  - Note: Tag requests made within 1 week of the sale date cannot be guaranteed to be delivered before sale day.
- Health forms must be submitted in person, e-mail, or fax for **EVERY** sale. Health forms may be picked up from the stockyard or printed from [www.norwoodfeederalf.com](http://www.norwoodfeederalf.com)
